WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- US citizens or permanent residents
- Certified content area teachers in NJ middle or high schools



PREFERRED QUALIFICATION

- Work in NJ public schools with high populations of Asian American Pacific Islander (AAPI) students.
- Teach STEM subjects or technology-enriched subjects.
- Demonstrate leadership skills, experience of mentoring novice teachers, or experience in curriculum development.
- Have not received a Fulbright award previously.



APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Fill out a application form [HERE](#).
2. Submit two letters of recommendation from a supervisor or a school administrator who can attest to the candidate's professional abilities and leadership skills.
3. Submit a sample lesson plan or a curriculum development plan
4. Attend an in-person interview with the grant team



PRE- & POST- TRIP REQUIREMENTS

- **Pre-Trip Workshop:** Accepted candidates must attend four pre-departure workshops (tentatively scheduled on 5/22, 6/05, 6/12, & 6/19 in 2024).
- **Post-Trip Professional Development:** Upon completion of the overseas travel to South Korea, participants are required to submit their lesson plans and learning modules. Participants are expected to present their work at a professional venue (e.g., Teaching Asia Conference). All deliverables are expected to be publicly available via the grant website.



TRAVEL AS A GROUP

Participants as a group will travel South Korea from late June to late July 2024 (overseas travel dates to be determined). The duration of the travel will be approximately 30 days. All travel expenses (e.g., airfare, lodging, meals, local transportation, activity fees, educational expenses, emergency medical expenses, etc.) will be covered by the grant. Participants are responsible for traveler's health insurance, visa application fees, personal medical expenses, and any other personal miscellaneous expenses.
